OUR UNDERSTANDING OF LEVEL 3 AT MARFELL COMMUNITY SCHOOL:

- Any child whose parents and caregivers have to leave home in order to go to work, and who can't be supervised at home by an appropriate person, needs to be able to attend school. Schools must be open for these children.
- When visiting school, parents, carers and whānau should keep 2 metres apart from people outside their household. A school bubble register must be completed at each visit,
- School bubbles are limited to 10 students.
- Teachers and children will not have to wear masks at school.
- Sanitise classroom surfaces regularly.
- **No school lunches provided, children must bring lunch from home.**
- All teachers are to maintain an online distance learning programme for their class, and provide additional hard packs if required.
- Onsite teachers are responsible for ensuring children complete their daily online tasks, and provide additional activities inline with long term plan e.g. geometry and speech writing, cross country art, music, P.E, biking.
- Children must use same digital device each day and sanitise
- Singing can be done only outside and 2 metres apart
- **We all need to work together with MANA to ensure;**
 - *We go forward together in unity.*

We currently have three bubbles operating within A Block being; the office, library and rooms 1 to 5.
